These items include: books, worksheets, notebooks, and if you don't have a computer at home, a Chromebook (grades 3 - 6). Most classes will have their first packet of work prepared for the children.
- Your child's needed items will be pre-organized on their classroom desk.
- I would suggest you bring your child's backpack or a bag to put the items in.
- If for some reason you cannot pick up items on Wednesday or Thursday, please call so that we can make other arrangements. Thank you for your help and cooperation.

Our teachers and myself will be in communication with you via email about how to proceed with the distance learning materials. In addition, I will keep you up-to-date on important information as it relates to COVID-19 and happenings associated with our school.
