Registration

1. Students must be residents of a Broome-Tioga BOCES component school district. Residency is determined by the individual district.
2. All student registration will be done at the home school to ensure students receive the appropriate class placement or Regents exam. Any student who does not report to class within the first three days of their scheduled class will be de-registered.
3. A completed health form, and IEP (if needed), must be on file in the summer school office before student is officially registered and allowed entrance to class/exam (students at the Binghamton site will also need to complete a computer access form).

* School counselors **cannot guarantee or reserve specific periods of the summer school day.**

Grades and granting of course credit

1. Credit for classes is awarded by the student's local school district based on the district's board policy and the recommendation of the summer school principal.
2. Students attending to receive new credit for a course **must** achieve 45 hours of instruction.



Classes run Monday through Thursday.

Period 1 8 - 11 a.m.

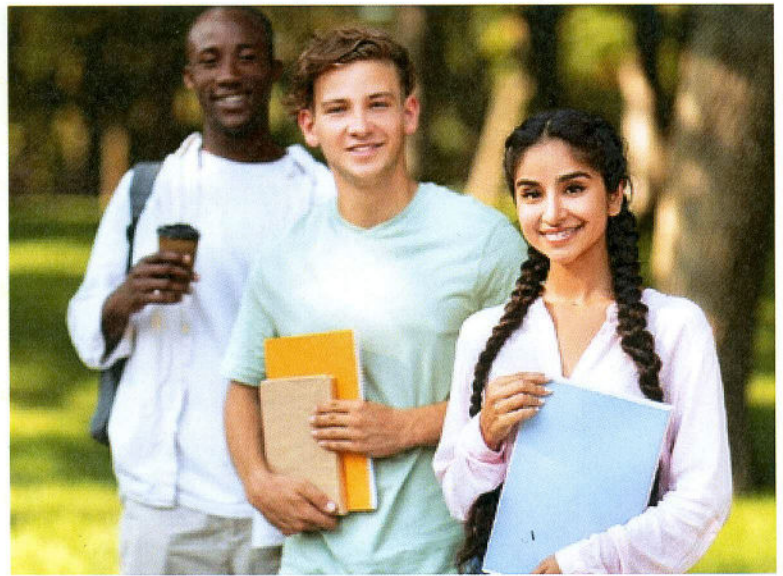

Policies

Attendance

1. Daily attendance is expected. Students taking computer-aided courses must adhere to the same attendance policy as the traditional summer school. There are no excused absences.
2. A significant portion of the class grade is based on classroom participation. Regents Prep/Credit Recovery students absent more than two days, including accumulated tardies, will be ineligible to be recommended for academic credit due to non-participation and will not be given final grades.
3. Three tardies = 1 absence.
Thirty minutes of missed class time will equal a full absence. This formula is applied to time out of class for disciplinary reasons as well.
4. Students new credit **must** complete 45 hours of instruction per state guidelines. Students absent more than one day, including accumulated tardies, will be ineligible to be recommended for academic credit due to non-participation and will not be given final grades.



Safety

2. Cell phones and all other electronic devices must be turned off upon entering the building.
