Sacred Heart Ukrainian Catholic Church is planning on sending another shipping container in December to Ukraine and currently do not have enough to fill it. We are asking the Seton community to help out in this endeavor.

Things that would be needed:

 new towels and fleeces, shaving cream, soap, hygiene products, diapers, dried or canned food (oatmeals, nuts, coffee, tea, etc.). *** A complete list is below from Sacred Hearts Facebook page.

The container will be shipped the week of December 11th. Items will be shipped through Poland to Lviv where they will be sent directly to the military or distributed through Catholic churches in the city of Lviv.

***During war time, basic needs are a true gift. We are stocking the container with:

- NEW children's clothing: winter coats, hats, gloves, socks, underwear, long underwear, thermal shirts and pants, pajamas, fleece sweaters (Up to age 18)
- dried foods such as oatmeal, rice, ramen, cereals, nuts, dried fruits, tea, coffee, chocolate
- nutrition bars and drinks like ensure
- baby food
- NEW blankets, fleeces, towels, pillows
- hygiene products: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, conditioner, hand towels, shaving cream, razor
- diapers children and adult
- medical supplies: such as crutches, walkers, braces, ace wraps, antibiotic creams, gauzes, wound care products, cold and flu medicine.

Please no toys or books. If you have a question if the item is needed, feel free to contact us. Items may be dropped off at Seton or Sacred Heart Ukrainian Church in Johnson City.
