FINAL EXAM/REGENTS SCHEDULE RELEASE

Our Guidance department has been hard at work developing our schedule for Final Exams and Regents. Please know that we tried very hard to limit conflicts. A few reminders

- Students only need to be in school if they have exams
- Morning exams start at 8:15 AM and afternoon exams start at 11:45 AM
- Students may not leave morning exams until 10:00 AM and afternoon exams until 2:00 PM
- Lunch will be available for purchase
- As much as we have tried not to, some students may have a conflict with their exam they must contact their counselor and teachers to work out a plan. (Regents exams cannot be changed)
- All students are expected to be in dress code during exams. We will allow dress/khaki shorts to be worn in lieu of
 pants because the gym/cafeteria can get warm during mid June. These shorts should be no more than 2 inches
 above the knee. Gym shorts are not allowed. Proper footwear (sneakers or shoes) are required. No sandals or
 slides will be allowed.
