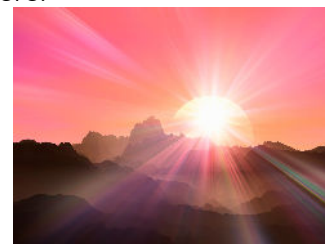


ALUMNI AROUND TOWN LANTERN FESTIVAL SEP 20
